

PREPARATION:

Position motorcycle securely on its sidestand. **Note:** It is not necessary to remove the bags.

Clean Fender

Squeeze in on the fender, position the Fender Tip. **Figure 1.**

Make sure the Fender Tip is symmetrical and is tight against the fender.

Mark the hole locations on the fender using the grease pencil or scribe. Remove the tip. **Figure 2.**

With the wood block between the Fender and the tire, drill a 1/4" hole through the fender at the marked locations. **Figure 3.**

INSTALLATION

- **1.** Position the Fender Tip in place on the front fender so the holes align.
- 2. Squeeze in on the fender tip and fender to start the Phillip screw. Insert screw through the Fender Tip and fender. Add a washer at the back. Thread the nut onto the screw. **Figure 5.**
- Tighten the screws securely. The nuts should be tight enough to avoid rattles.
- **4**. Check the tightness of the nuts after about ten miles of riding.

CARE AND MAINTENANCE: Clean and polish with a chrome cleaner/polish. Check tightness of the nuts regularly.
